SUBJECT: **PUBLIC COMMENT** – Transportation of Non-Radioactive Materials and Low-Level Radioactive Wastes Operations

Port San Luis Harbor District Staff has reviewed the **Transportation Risks Associated with the Decommissioning of Nuclear Power Plants: Methodology and Application to Diablo Canyon Power Plant** document and will be monitoring the Diablo Canyon Power Plant (DCPP) Decommissioning Engagement Panel meeting on Wednesday, June 24, 2020. We understand the key topic for this meeting is discussion and input regarding the transportation of non-radioactive and low-level radioactive waste materials.

We have noted that three transportation routes from Diablo Canyon were evaluated:

- 1) southern route thru Avila Beach
- 2) northern route through Montana De Oro
- 3) via sea

After the Decommissioning Panel meeting, discussion and input, the Harbor District will agendaize this item for discussion at a future Board of Commissioners meeting with the intent to provide comments regarding the transportation routes and any other pertinent issues.
